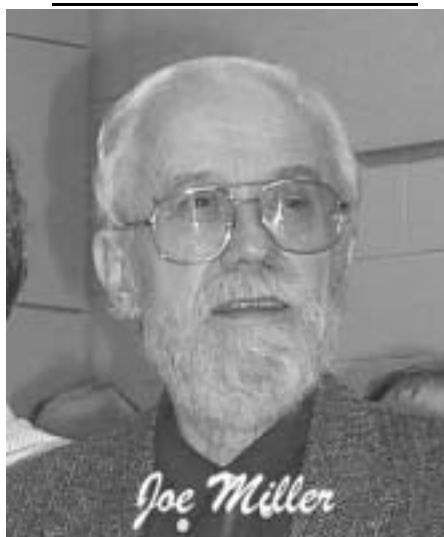

#### Digital Magic

Mary Ann retired in 1998 from the National Education Association where she worked as Personnel Manager for twenty years. In 1994, she enrolled in Washington School of Photography, graduating with professional certification. She concentrated on learning Adobe Photoshop so that she could focus on her real objective: "creating 'photographic art'". Together with her husband she created a home business, PictureProse. On the photography side, she offers traditional and boudoir portraiture (both with film and digital cameras) in her home studio and digital photographic services such as making collages, modifying images, and restoring old prints. She wants to share her enthusiasm at what is possible in our photographic world from the digital perspective. During the program she will talk about what she envisions when creating images and what she has learned in the four-year trek of trying to conquer Adobe Photoshop, with the hope of inspiring newcomers to the world of digital imaging. She will briefly cover technical equipment but will primarily discuss various skills in Photoshop that photographers can employ from the basics to more involved techniques. She will share many of her own images, even the early ones, as well as some before-and-after examples in order to illustrate those skills.

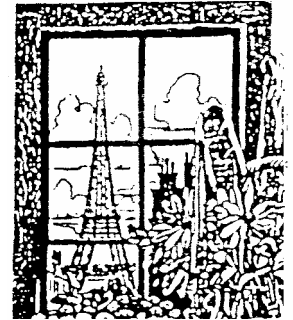

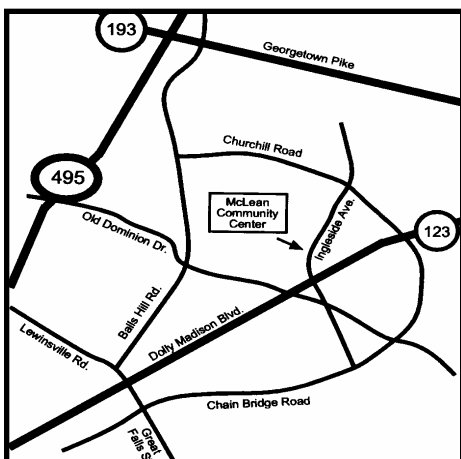
